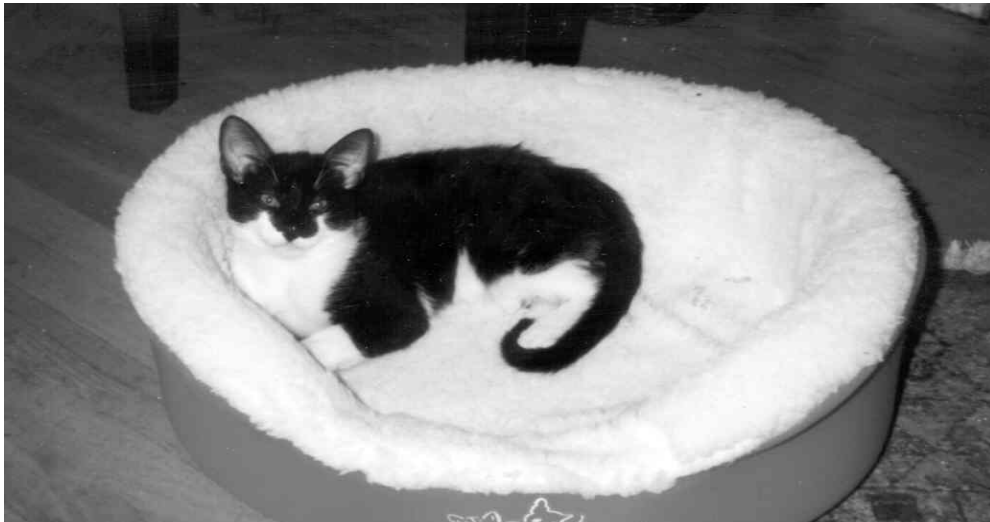

Trooper (aka "Lazarus") was rescued from Valley Community College. He had been beaten and left for dead. Because of his injuries, including severe blunt trauma to the head, he is blind and has a compromised immune system. He will require special medical care for his entire life, but we have found him a warm and loving home. Cats are abandoned daily on the Valley College campus and throughout the city. Many of them meet a fate worse than that of Trooper. The volunteers of **FORGOTTEN ANIMALS OF LOS ANGELES** work tirelessly to help these animals, and so many others.

- We promote spaying and neutering of all felines and canines, for health and overpopulation.
- We maintain and protect feral cat colonies.
